Rickla sleeps 2-4 persons and is let as a single unit.

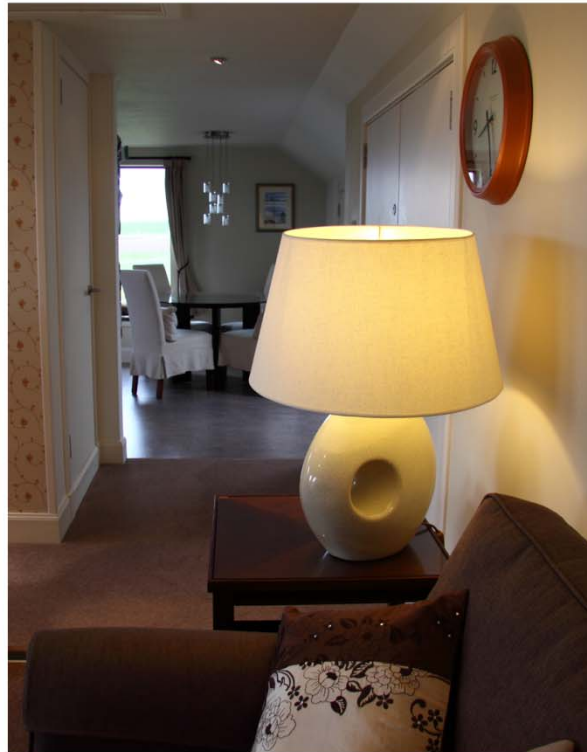
We welcome guests all year round. Lettings in main season are Saturday-Saturday. Short breaks (minimum 3 nights) are also possible when availability permits.

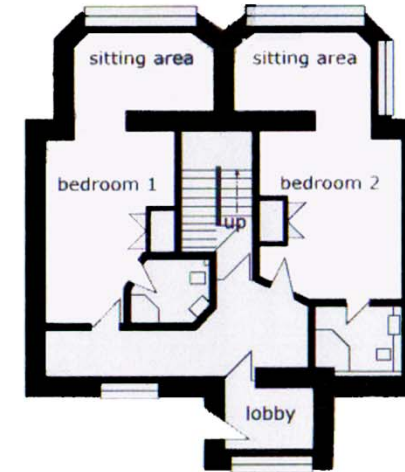

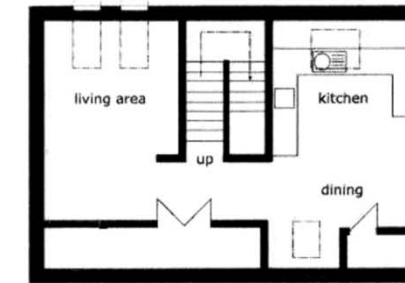

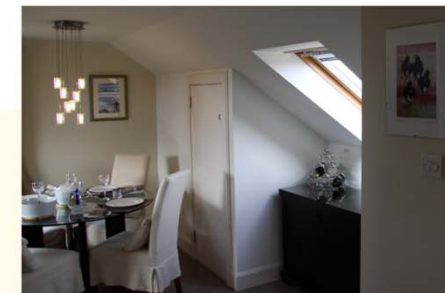


Floorplans
